General Definition of Work

Performs intermediate semiskilled work directing the work of custodial staff, cleaning school building interiors, maintaining school grounds, and related work as apparent or assigned. Work is performed under the general direction of the Assistant Director. Continuous oversight is exercised over Custodian I.

Qualification Requirements

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable an individual with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Essential Functions

Directs and supervises the work of custodial staff.

Acts as a Custodian I.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

General knowledge of cleaning methods, materials and equipment; ability to understand and follow simple oral and written directions; ability to read; ability to display thoroughness and cleanliness; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with associates.

Education and Experience

High school diploma or GED and moderate experience performing custodial work, cleaning industrial or school buildings, or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Physical Requirements

This work requires the frequent exertion of up to 50 pounds of force and occasional exertion of up to 100 pounds of force; work regularly requires standing, using hands to finger, handle or feel and reaching with hands and arms, frequently requires walking, pushing or pulling and repetitive motions and occasionally requires sitting, speaking or hearing, climbing or balancing and stooping, kneeling, crouching or crawling; work has standard vision requirements; vocal communication is required for expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word; hearing is required to perceive information at normal spoken word levels; work requires visual inspection involving small defects and/or small parts, using of measuring devices, assembly or fabrication of parts within arms length, operating machines, operating motor vehicles or equipment and observing general surroundings and activities; work frequently requires working near moving mechanical parts, exposure to fumes or airborne particles and exposure to outdoor weather conditions and occasionally requires working in high, precarious places, exposure to toxic or caustic chemicals, exposure to the risk of electrical shock, exposure to vibration and exposure to bloodborne pathogens and may be required to wear specialized personal protective equipment; work is generally in a moderately noisy location (e.g. business office, light traffic).

Special Requirements

Valid driver's license in the State of Minnesota.
